Dear Judge Shwartz:

I write to you in your capacity as a New Jersey member of the Federal Judges Association and as a federal judge who knows me professionally as the law partner of Mark Anderl,

I am sure you are familiar with the tragic facts of the day when Mark and Esther's home was ruthlessly invaded. Because of the severity of Mark's injuries, it is uncertain whether or when he will be able to return to the practice of law. He will also require prolonged rehabilitation. Because of the risks attending Covid-19, it has been recommended that he receive that care at home. There is no insurance coverage available to cover those costs.

To help, a trust has been established solely for Mark's benefit. Before it was finalized, Judge Salas consulted with the Administrative Office and Codes of Conduct Committee to make certain that the trust was structured in a way that would avoid any ethical issues.

My request is that members of the FJA be alerted to the existence of the trust, and receive by email a single-page description of the trust—a hard copy of which included. By no means do I ask that judges be solicited, only that the Association alert them to the existence of the trust as a point of information, in whatever words are deemed most appropriate. In addition, please know that I have been in communication with Judge McHugh in Philadelphia as our Circuit's representative to the Codes of Conduct Committee about how a request like this might be made.

It would be greatly appreciated if you would approach your board with this request to make known the existence of the trust for my law partner, Mark Anderl.
